Brian will sign copies of his books and can include a dedication to your child. You can buy the books at a discounted price of just £6.00 each (or £27.50 for all five) and Brian will donate all proceeds from

these sales to two important charities that support people who have suffered a spinal injury - the Spinal Injuries Association and Back Up.
