School Meals Price Increase

I do not need to tell anyone about the impact of inflation on almost every aspect of our lives at the moment. Unfortunately, school meals are no exception to this. From April, our school meal providers are increasing the amount they charge per meal to £2.55. After Easter, any junior child who is not entitled to free school meals and who has a school dinner will be charged this amount. This will be payable as normal using the cashless system. All infants still have a school dinner paid for by the Government. If your child is in the infants or the juniors, and you think that you may be entitled to free school meals, please contact the school office. This not only ensures that your child receives a nutritious meal, but it also triggers extra funding that we can use to support them in school.



Rotakids Supporting Yorkshire Air Ambulance

The week started with our Rotakids putting on their first organised event. Their chosen charity was Yorkshire Air Ambulance and the group (with more than a little help and support from home) did a brilliant job with their bake sale.
