### Clubs

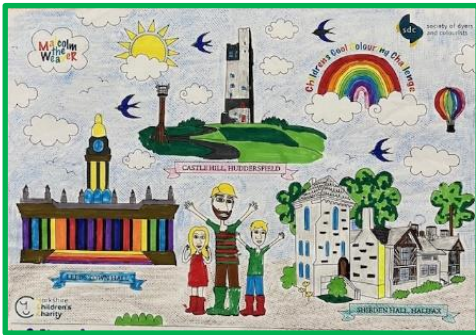

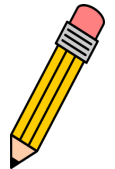
